

Brother and NFC Compatible Mobile Devices

- NFC refers to “Near Field Communication”, a new technology that automatically establishes a Wi-Fi Direct connection between an NFC enabled Smartphone or tablet and a NFC compatible Brother device.
- Using Brother’s iPrint&Scan app on an NFC compatible mobile device allows you to directly print to and scan from the NFC compatible Brother device.
- Please note that your Smartphone or tablet must be running Android OS version 4.0 or later to support this capability.
- If you are unable to connect via NFC successfully, you may need to update the firmware on your Brother device to a version that supports NFC.
