- Brother ScanNCut machine
- A selection of scrapbook paper
- Tea lights
- Stamp pad and stamps
- Oddments of ribbon, buttons, scrapbook ephemera
- Pencil
- Ruler

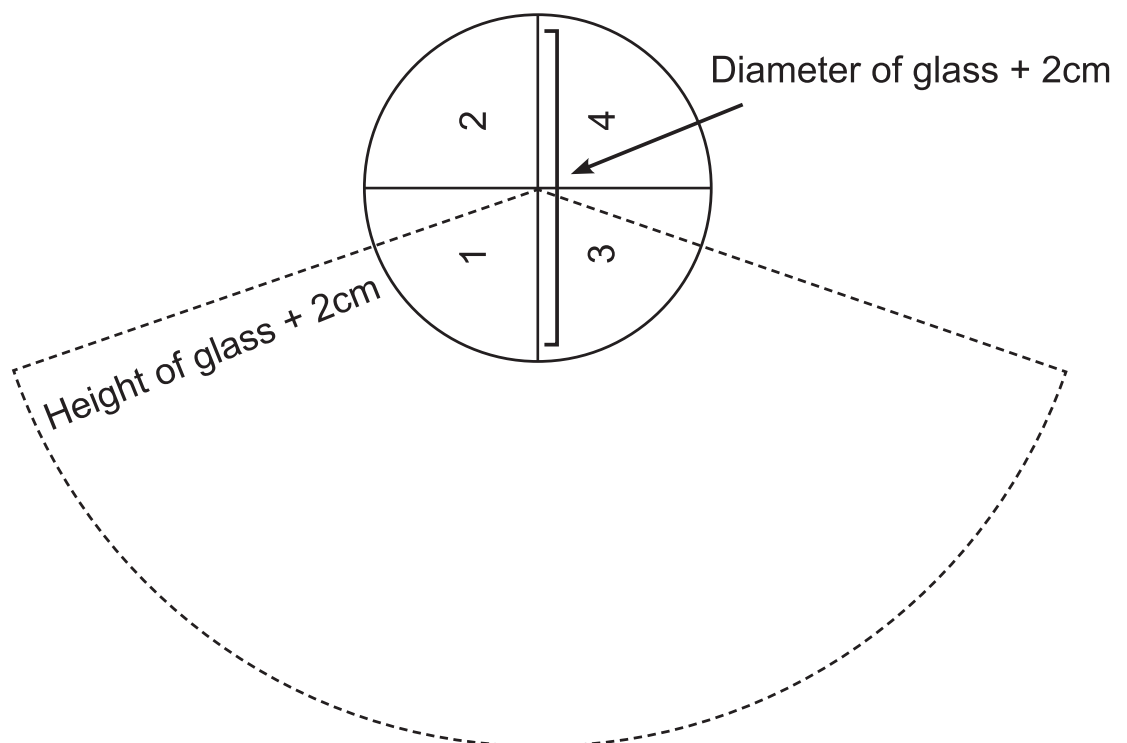
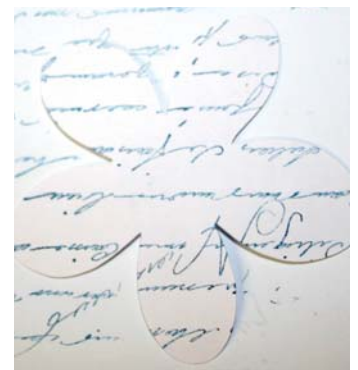
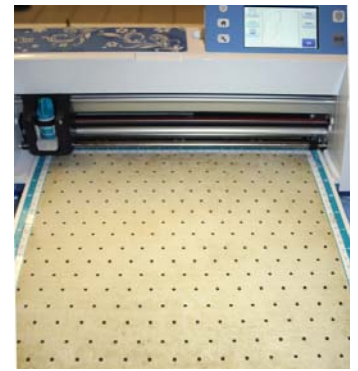
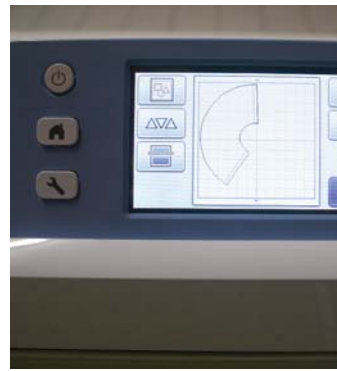
1 Measure the diameter of the opening of the glass and add 2 cm to the measurement. Draw a circle using those measurements. Divide the circle into quarters. Divide quarters 1 and 3 in half again and draw a dotted line.

2 Measure the height of the glass without the steel of the glass and add 2 cm to that measurement. Extend the dotted lines in quarters 1 and 3 at a 10 degree slant with these measurements. Use a round plate to connect the two dotted lines with one another.

3 Cut out the template and scan into the ScanNCut machine. Position the paper you wish to use on the standard cutting matt of the ScanNCut machine and cut out the first shade. Use double sided tape to glue the two sides together.

4 Embellish the shades with cut outs from the ScanNCut machine, rhinestones etc. Use electric tea light candles inside the glass to prevent the paper from catching fire.
